In an effort to offer further services and convenience to our clients, we are implementing a “pilot program” to offer house calls for wellness exams and vaccinations in the comfort of your own home!

Perfect for:

- Nervous cats - no more stuffing your cat in a carrier!
- Geriatric patients that may have difficulty getting in and out of the car.
- Multiple pets - have all of your pets vaccinated at one time!
- Elderly owners that have to arrange travel for their pets.

What we offer:

- Prescription/Heartworm/Flea prevention with advanced notice
- At-home euthanasia

Fees:

HOUSE CALL FEES (measured in a radius from the hospital):

Up to 5 miles: \$48

5-10 miles: \$58

10-15 miles: \$68

Greater than 15 miles: based on special approval - fee to be determined

Our examination and vaccine prices are the same as our in hospital prices, and our house call fee is competitive with other mobile veterinary services in the metro Atlanta area.

House Call Program

Please note:

All pets receiving vaccinations/treatments are required to have an examination.

We are not equipped to diagnose/treat most medical conditions/emergencies during a house call- please schedule an appointment in hospital for these services.

We are unable to transport pets to or from households for any reason. The only exception to this rule is transporting a deceased pet back to the hospital after an at-home euthanasia which should be scheduled in advance.

We do not recommend this service for aggressive dogs. Aggressive/nervous dogs can often exhibit territorial aggression, making home visits dangerous for owners and our staff. These types of dogs often do better in a hospital environment, where the instinct to protect their home is eliminated.

Please have all pets readily available before we arrive for your appointment - cats should be confined to a bathroom or other small room prior to our arrival. We will be unable to extend your appointment time to allow you to locate any hidden pets, and a house call fee will be charged in the event you are unable to find your pet for examination/vaccination.

We will have a fixed time in your home to complete our examinations and other procedures. Please schedule accordingly for the number of pets that are to be seen. Unexpected additions may be seen if time allows.

Please allow a 15 minute window before/after your scheduled appointment time for our arrival to account for travel difficulties. We will give you a courtesy call if we encounter any further delay of your appointment.

We reserve the right to refuse treatment to any pet that is unsafe to handle - home sedation for examination/vaccination is not available.

We apologize for any inconvenience.

Payment is expected at time of service. We accept either personal checks (established clients) or credit card processed over the phone.
